All art submissions must utilize or depict denim in some way, and all art submissions must bring awareness to sexual violence and/or to those who it affects. Artists may use whichever medium (photography, film, pastels, paint, etc.) that they are most comfortable displaying their expression of this topic. Artists may request to receive up to 4lbs. of recycled denim, if needed, while supplies last.

We must receive art submissions by April 8th, and upon acceptance, art will be displayed during the Millville Art District's Third Friday event on April 15th. All art submitted art will be considered a charitable donation and will be auctioned off during the event to raise funds to support sexual violence prevention and awareness education and victim services.
